Dear fellow soccer players:

Well it is time again to begin organizing our spring tournament. This year the tournament will be from April 3rd to 5th and will be run along the same lines as in past years. For the first time, a few evening games will be scheduled in order to keep play on the Parklands rugby field to a minimum and to allow teams to opt for only one game on the Sunday. It is expected that no more than four games will be played on Friday and Saturday evenings. Teams will be consulted prior to scheduling them in evening games.

Once again, this year we will be having an Over 40 and Over 50 division for the men and an Over 30 Masters Division for the women. Registration notices are being sent out to all of our usual teams plus a few others. If you know of any teams up island, on the mainland or down in the states that might be interested in joining us this year, please feel free to forward this notice on to them or pass a contact name along to us so that we can do so.

As in the past, we will make every effort to schedule games to facilitate travel for the out of town teams and to accommodate special requests. Unfortunately, this is not always possible but we will do our best to do so and, at the same time, to make sure that each team has opportunities to play against teams that they normally do not meet during the playing season.

For teams entering our tournament for the first time, we will be playing our games on the two Blue Heron park fields and on the two Parklands Secondary School fields. Each team will play four games. The games will consist of two thirty minute halves. Extra time will not be allowed for tiebreakers. As in the past, the spring tournament will be a fun tournament. There are no prizes and no playoffs. Teams are reminded that their entries should be restricted to their normal team rosters and players should not be recruited from other teams in order to stack the team.

The entry deadline is February 28th. Priority will be given to SVICSA teams whose registration and payment are received by the entry deadline date. After that, all entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis regardless of whether the teams have SVICSA or non SVICSA affiliations. Notwithstanding this, all teams are encouraged to send their entries in as soon as possible to avoid disappointment.

NOTE: SVICSA TEAMS ARE NOT AUTOMATICALLY ENTERED IN THIS TOURNAMENT.
